STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT NEW PALTZ (SUNY NEW PALTZ) (2015-present)

Assistant Professor

INTRODUCTION TO PERFORMANCE (formerly ACTING I)

A practical exploration of the art and craft of acting, with emphasis on the body, voice, and actor's imagination. This course provides the beginning student with basic techniques and vocabulary through exercises, monologues, and scene work.

ACTING I (formerly ACTING II)

Understanding the basic craft of acting through fundamental technique based on the methods of Stanislavski and American derivations including Meisner, Hagen, Adler, and Strasberg. Attention to rehearsal process as applied to scene work in contemporary American Realism.

THEATRE IV

A capstone course for all senior theatre majors. Students will focus on preparation for entering the professional entertainment industry in their specific area of specialization and/or continuing education. Material explored in this course will be implemented in Acting III.

AFRICAN-AMERICAN DRAMA (online & seated)

This course is a lecture and discussion course that explores African-American drama. Students will read and discuss the works of prominent African-American playwrights. Lectures will provide cultural context for discussions about the types of drama written, performed, and produced by African-Americans from slavery to the present day. Students will examine these works through historical context and a contemporary lens. Student written and oral presentations will analyze play texts and express critical engagement with the literature.

UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH (PITT) (2012-2015)

Visiting Lecturer

ACTING II: Acting the 20th century: Ibsen to Pinter

Acting II builds on the work of Acting I with a deeper exploration of Realism and Naturalism on stage through textual analysis, scene study, physical exercises, research and performance. The material in the course focuses on works of European and American playwrights. Theoretical work would be complementary, based on the tradition of practitioners like Constantin Stanislavski, Richard Boleslavsky, Stella Adler and Lee Strasberg, deepening a student's understanding of psychological realism.

Teaching Artist-in-Residence

INTRODUCTION TO PERFORMANCE

This course is designed to develop the students' awareness of the actor's process and to foster a general sense of theatre as an area of human endeavor. Students will be introduced to basic communication skills, including physical and vocal presence in front of an audience. The course will also develop an introductory level of acting skill through the use of regular warm-ups, theater games, improvisation, and simple scene study. The class will culminate in the performance of a final scene.

ACTING I

This course continues the work begun in Introduction to Performance, focusing on Contemporary Drama and American Realism. Students will learn to perform scene work within emotionally invested circumstances, improve moment to moment skills as well as talking and listening skills, play objectives, and apply given circumstances and text analysis to character development.

BUSINESS MANAGEMENT: Career Development for Performers

The aim of this course is to introduce theatrical performers to the resources and opportunities available in theatre professions, related fields, and continuing education. The objectives are to assist the student in identifying academic and career goals and developing strategies for achieving a successful process. Performers will develop audition material, resumes, headshots and related materials necessary for the successful attainment of their career objectives. In addition, students will be asked to think in a larger context anticipating long range planning to consider the career as a business model.
