

Professional Expertise

I am Associate Professor and Chair for the University of Pittsburgh Theatre Arts Department as well as being a professional USA 829 Lighting Designer. As Chair, I am responsible for all dayto-day operations of the department. The University of Pittsburgh Theatre Arts Department has 11 faculty and 9 staff. The department produces between 8 and 10 productions per year performing approximately 100 performances, using 3 theatre spaces: a 99 seat studio theatre, 172 seat thrust theatre, 400 seat proscenium stage. I manage a yearly budget of \$1,668,443 for all academic and production cost. The department, on average, offers 100 course sections per year. My talents and skills as an artist, manager, and academic allow me to work side-by-side with colleagues to keep all theatre interests on task throughout the year. As a designer, I am responsible for all of the artistic lighting elements of a theatrical production. The foundation of my design and teaching work is the conceptualization of a script to create a dynamic complete environment for the world of the theatrical piece. I also work within and teach theories of collaboration and communication, working toward a final product that is not only artistically successful but also has been completed with cooperation and teamwork resulting in the creation of a collaborative work. I am experienced in current lighting technology, such as programming computerized light boards with both conventional and automated lighting equipment. In the implementation of my designs, I use, and am proficient in, current lighting computer programs as well as general computer programs that can be useful in my field. As an Associate Professor, I have been responsible for teaching courses in Lighting Design, Stage Management, Introduction to Design, and Computer-Aided-Drafting. I have developed an independent course of study in Vectorworks and Lightwright as well as serving as a mentor to student designers in lighting, sound, projections and stage management.
